The Reverend Tamica L. Robinson is a native of Salisbury, North Carolina and currently resides in Charlotte, North Carolina. She was educated in the public school system of Mecklenburg County and graduated from East Mecklenburg High School. She holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration with a concentration in Accounting and a minor in Marketing from Barber-Scotia College, Concord, NC (May 1996). She attended Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary from 2003 to 2005. Likewise, she matriculated at Hood Theological Seminary, Salisbury, NC, in May 2009 where she earned the Master of Divinity degree, cum laude honors and was the recipient of several scholarships during her academic tenure.

After graduation from Barber-Scotia College, Reverend Robinson was employed with Wells Fargo Bank (formerly First Union/Wachovia Corporation) for over 10 years as a Dividend Reinvestment Specialist and for Transamerica Life & Annuities Company as a Contract Administrator.

In 2002, she accepted her call to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ and delivered her trail sermon on January 19, 2003. She was ordained a Deacon in September 2007 and an Elder in September 2009 in the African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church both under the leadership of the Right Reverend George W.C. Walker, Sr., retired Bishop of the A. M. E. Zion Church.

- Assistant Administrative Assistance to the Salisbury District Presiding Elder, Salisbury District Treasurer, Budget Chairperson, State of the Church Committee and sings with the District Choir
- Secretary to the Walls Advisory Board of AME Zion Church and
- Secretary to the Hood Theological Seminary National Alumni Association

Previously, she has served as the Assistant Statistician to the WNC Annual Conference; the Salisbury District Financial Secretary, Finance Committee, Evangelism Committee, and Assistant Secretary to the Hood National Alumni Association.
