



## **Director of United Methodist Studies and Student Recruitment**

Hood Theological Seminary (HTS) invites applications for a Director of United Methodist Studies and Student Recruitment, a full-time position that comes with full-time, tenure-track faculty status. Teaching responsibilities include offering one of the following United Methodist Basic Graduate Theological Studies courses — United Methodist history, United Methodist polity, Methodist doctrine, Evangelism, or Mission of the church in the world — each semester on both of the Seminary's two course tracks. (On Track I each course meets Tues., Wed., or Thurs. and on Track II Fri. or Sat.). Administrative responsibilities include United Methodist student recruitment and advisement, establishing and maintaining collaborative connections with regional United Methodist Annual Conferences, and ensuring that the Seminary's curriculum continues to prepare United Methodist students effectively for ordained Christian ministry. Minimum qualifications include Ph.D. or Th.D. in United Methodist history, doctrine, or related field (e.g., systematic theology, church history, or historical theology); potential for excellence in classroom instruction; willingness to work collaboratively with faculty and staff colleagues; membership in the United Methodist Church; and commitment to the Seminary's institutional mission.

Hood Theological Seminary, founded in 1879, is sponsored by the A.M.E. Zion Church and has a diverse faculty and student body. In 2013 the Association of Theological Schools in the United States and Canada reaffirmed HTS's accreditation for ten years. In 2014 the University Senate of the United Methodist Church reaffirmed HTS's place on its list of approved seminaries. Located in historic Salisbury, NC, the HTS campus is approximately 1 hour from Charlotte, Greensboro, and Winston-Salem.
