ABOUT THE AAMP SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient of the Adopt-A-Minister Project (AAMP) scholarship will be supported throughout their pursuit of their Masters of Divinity Degree studies at Hood Theological Seminary. Once selected, the recipient is adopted into family of the Daughters of Conference and becomes a son/daughter of Trinity A.M.E. Zion Church. The recipient must maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA and remain in satisfactory financial standings at Seminary throughout their studies.

HOW DOES A MINISTER BECOME ADOPTED?

- Express a desire for consideration either verbally or in written form.
- Recommendation to the AAMP Committee by any member of Daughters of Conference or by a Pastor of the AME Zion Church.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR CONSIDERATION

- Anyone who has accepted the call for ministerial service - no age restrictions.
- Must be currently attending Hood Theological Seminary or plan to enroll at Hood to earn the Masters of Divinity Degree.
- Good moral and ethical standing in the AME Zion Church.
- Must be committed to Zion Methodism.
- Applicants who are currently enrolled at Hood must be in satisfactory financial standing and not on probation.
- Applicants who are currently enrolled at Seminary must submit a transcript validating a minimum 3.0 GPA.
