There disputes over doctrines;

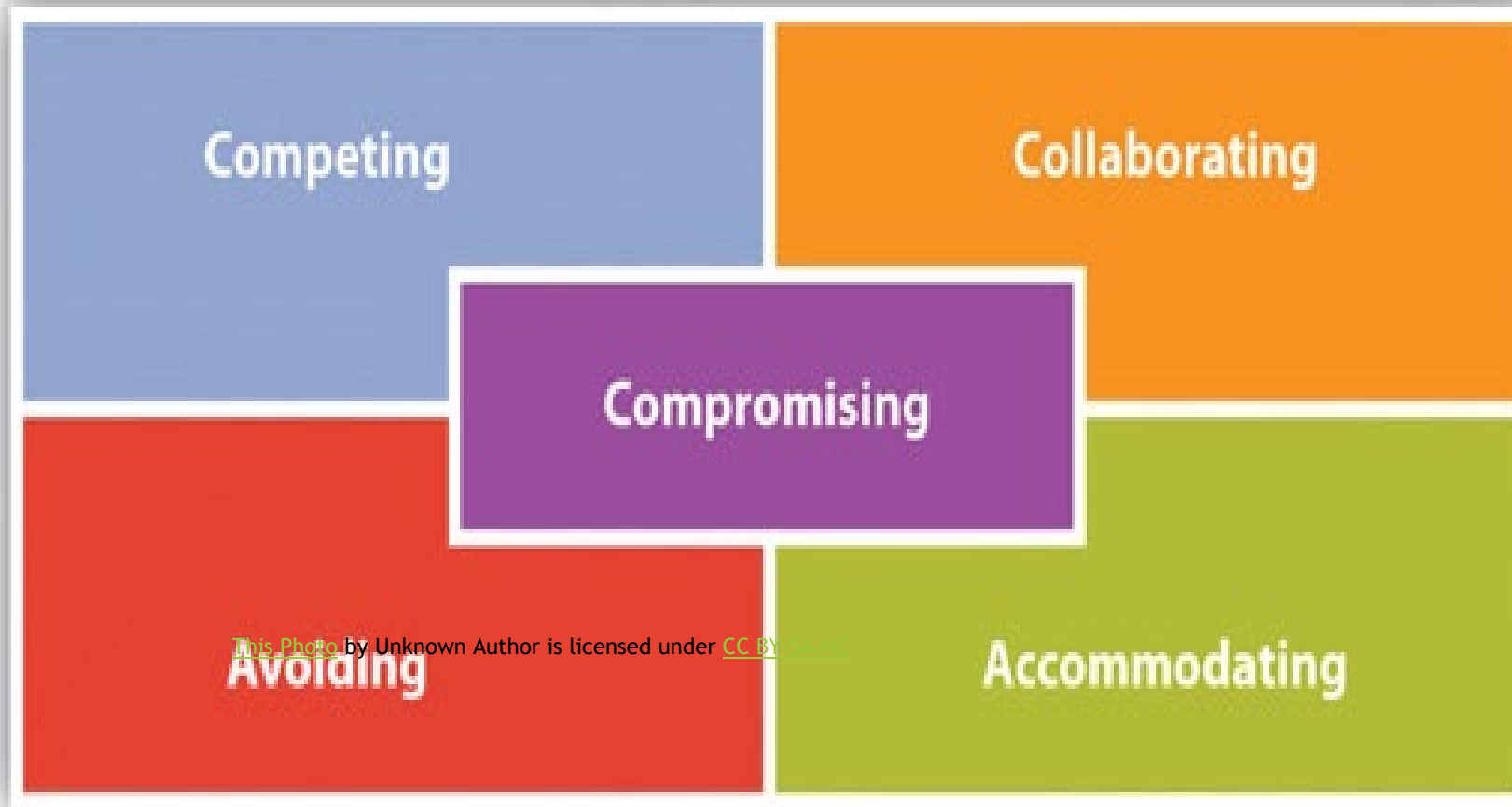
Paul calls for unity in the church.

# 7 Causes of Conflict

1. *Satan's Influence.* The Bible describes Satan as a deceiver and father of lies, who disguises himself as an angel of light and goes around the earth tempting individuals and looking for people to devour.
2. *Personal Attributes, Attitudes, and Action.* Interpersonal tension often begins and escalates with people whose personality traits, attitudes, perceptions, feelings, mannerisms, and behavior create conflict and distrust.

3. **Group Attitudes and Belief**. These group beliefs impact individuals within the group, influencing how they think and act toward people who are in a different group. The group beliefs can be dangerous idea that propel groups to conflict.
4. **Conflict Pattern**. Conflict involves a struggle that occurs when two or more people have goals that appear to be incompatible, or when they want something that is scarce.

5. *Lack of Commitment*. In this postmodernism, loyalty to friends, family, church, business associates, and country is discarded when it gets in the way of self-fulfillment or personal advancement.
6. *Communication Failure*. The essence of good interpersonal relations is good communication. Interpersonal tensions often arises when communication is inefficient or in danger of breaking down.

- 7. Social Irritants. Event or conditions in society can prevent or hinder good interpersonal relations, such as:**
- ▶ **Crowded and uncomfortable urban areas;**
  - ▶ **Prolonged heat waves;**
  - ▶ **Squabbling in the house;**
  - ▶ **Economic strife (Can you name others?).**



Step one

Separate the people from the problem.

Step two

Focus of the issues, not the positions.

Step three

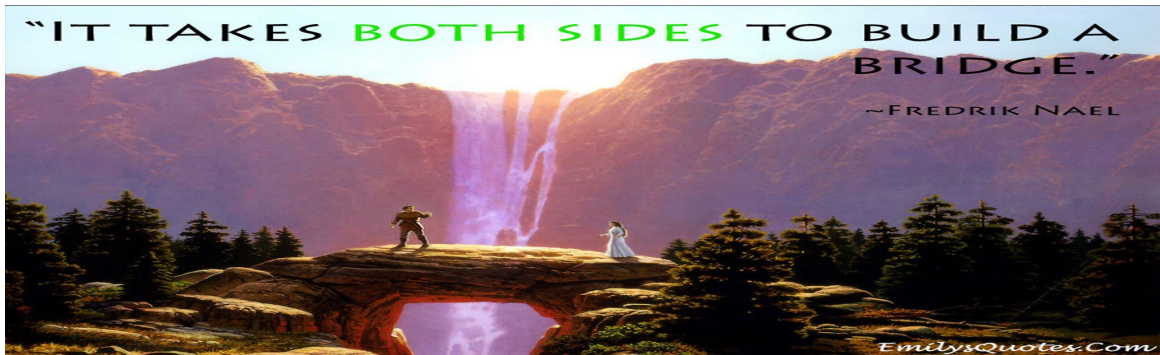
Think of various options that might solve the problem.

Step four

Insist on an objective, mutually accepted way to agree on how the problem will be solved.
