Hood's EduWorship Experience

EduWorship is an intentional experience at Hood Theological Seminary that brings awareness to *Breast Cancer, Children and Domestic Violence*. This annual event was held October 24, 2023, at the Aymer Center using the theme "*Pressing Forward for Advocacy, Well-being and Justice*." Minister Loria Lofton, owner of IMBESI Counseling and Life Care, PLLC in central Texas was the educator. Her company works to provide mental/behavioral health services to the underserved and disadvantages in the area. Lofton encouraged participants to examine first what "*In the Press*." Then she explored "*DIRE Times*". The word

DIRE served as an acronym that posed a charge to participants who need to **Discern, Identify, Recognize** and **Empower** to make a difference where service is rendered.

Dr. Angela Peterkin, Chaplin at Salisbury Veterans Hospital rendered a musical witness. Not only was this an opportunity to worship and educate, but it was also an opportunity to bless. Hood was intentional in blessing three Salisbury agencies: Terri Hess Child Advocacy Center, Family Crisis Center – Battered Women's Shelter, and Rowan Helping Ministries. Each agency received a table of blessings including items to meet the needs of their clients.





FaithLearnThrive Launches 2nd Foundations For Thriving Learning Community

FaithLearnThrive (FLT) is the Thriving Congregations initiative at Hood Seminary. On October 13th-14th, we launched our second learning community. Foundations For Thriving is a 10-module learning journey to prepare your church for growth and revitalization. We've taken best practices from hundreds of churches and have developed a program to help you create a foundational growth strategy for your church.

The learning community provides congregational coaches, a coaching community for pastors, monthly facilitated sessions, books, resources, and micro-grant funding for administrative upgrades.

This year's learning community leveraged vital learnings from our pilot community in 2022-2023 to offer congregations a richer experience. Our launch weekend features a customized format for a more collaborative environment among participants. We featured Speed Coach Bonding, intentional cross-congregational meals and conversations, free books from our Hood Library, and an overnight experience, extending the time for our participants and coaches to bond.
