Randolph Health Clinical Adjunct Chaplain

The one required qualification for this position is having completed at least one unit of Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE). The position requires that the candidate be on-call for the hospital one week per month and reside within 45 minutes of drive time from the hospital. It may occur that the candidate would be on-call a portion of another week within the same month, too, depending on how the calendar matches with the rotation of on-calls. Currently, there are three other Clinical Adjunct Chaplains serving Randolph Health. It would also be expected that the candidate work on-site five hours each day, Monday-Friday, of the week that they are on-call. The unique component for Randolph Health is that the candidate is compensated for every minute of the week s/he is on-call. Please click on the job description below for further information.




